Speakers' Bureau

The speakers listed in this directory have given their consent to being included in our Speakers' Bureau. They are looking forward to sharing their God given gifts with you.

Many of these speakers are willing to develop new topics to meet the needs of the group and that is noted on their information presented in this booklet. A listing of each speaker's prepared topics, their speaking engagement preferences, their personal biographical information, and contact information is provided. This information is intended to assist every society, zone, or group in the selecting and planning of an appropriate program for their various LWML meetings. Some speakers provide expanded biographical information and/or personal speaking brochures or fliers. The LWML Michigan District Christian Events Coordinator is available to assist societies, zones, and groups in the use of the Speakers' Bureau and any additional information available regarding speakers. It is the prayer of the LWML Michigan District Christian Growth Committee that this Speakers' Bureau will be a valuable resource in your LWML planning and work.

Lutheran Heritage Foundation offers program without cost to LWML societies, zones, districts, and congregations. Many organizations do, however, choose to reimburse travel and/or housing, provide an in-gathering, or present and honorarium. These are solely at the discretion of the inviting organization.

Guidelines for the Speakers' Bureau

- 1. A prospective speaker will be referred to the Coordinator of Christian Events. In order to be considered, the individual is to be a member of an LCMS Church.*
- 2. The Coordinator will send a cover letter and an application form to be filled out by the prospective speaker.*
- 3. Upon receipt of the completed form, the Coordinator will send the form to the District President for approval. The President is to initial and date the form to show her approval and return the same to the Coordinator.*
- 4. Upon approval, the Coordinator will send a letter to the speaker acknowledging receipt of the form and the acceptance to the Speakers' Bureau.*
- 5. The completed form will be placed into an active file. A list of current speakers will be distributed to the Board of Directors at the end of each biennium.*
- 6. Groups looking for an event speaker may contact the Coordinator for more information about a speaker.*

ENGAGING & WORKING WITH SPEAKERS (A GENERAL GUIDELINE)

- A. *Speakers should be contacted well in advance of the meeting.*
- B. *Written communication inviting the speaker should include:*
- *Name of organization inviting*
 - *Date, time, place, size of audience*
 - *Theme of meeting*
 - *Expected topic to speak about (make suggestions)*
 - *Time allotted for speech and if question/answer period will follow*
 - *Advise if speaker is to be involved in other phases of meeting*
 - *Explain expenses to be reimbursed: honorarium, mileage, meals, lodging*
 - *Ask speaker to respond by set deadline*
- C. *Written communication after a speaker accepts includes:*
- *Reconfirm date, time, meeting place*
 - *Reconfirm length of presentation and presentation title*
 - *Inquire about special needs: projector, screen, overhead, tape recorder, etc.*
 - *Request a biography to use for introduction*
 - *Provide name of hostess*
 - *Provide address and map of meeting place and contact telephone numbers*
 - *Advise where guest should be seated and when introduction will be made*
 - *If recording, ask for permission to record presentation*
- D. *Hosting the speaker:*
- *Hostess should know how to correctly pronounce speaker's name and be familiar with biography of speaker to help with conversation*
 - *Assigned hostess should meet guest upon arrival and remain attentive during stay*
 - *Assist with materials, show where restrooms are located, introduce to officers, etc.*
 - *Prior to presentation, permit guest to have a period of private time*
 - *Have honorarium ready with a "ThankYou" note*
 - *Make certain all expenses are paid*
 - *See that guest is with people during social time*

The general guideline "Engaging and Working with Speakers" was taken from the LWML Michigan District Energizer Kit. A handy step-by-step checklist, to thoroughly assist groups in event planning and guest speaking, is available through "Event Planners and Guest Speakers: Partners with a Purpose" by Jean Garton and Ruth N. Koch. This information is published by LWML—Lutheran Women in Mission and can be ordered through the LWML Catalog.
